

Chiswick Farmers and Fine Food Market

Details

- Hours** Every Sunday open to customers from 10am to 2pm. (Producers can arrive and start setting up from 8.am. It is advisable to arrive by at least 9:15 if you need an electricity supply.)
- Site** In front of the Pavilion, Dukes Meadows, Market Drive, off Alexandra Gardens, Chiswick W4 2RX.
- Spaces** Only pitches are provided. Producers should bring their own stalls and umbrellas/canopies, if required. Producers with refrigerated vehicles will be able to keep their vehicles on site other producers will be able to park immediately adjacent to the site. If you require electricity, you will need to bring a suitable external grade extension lead. (Power breaker sockets will be available.) Hand washing and toilet facilities are available for producers close by. Producers selling meat, poultry, fish, cheese, or cooked products must have hot water on their stall.
- Fee** 10% of average takings, £25 minimum charge

Getting to Chiswick Farmers and Fine Food Market

From the West

Drive along the M4 to its eastern most end (J1) (don't take the Chiswick Exit from the M4) then continue along the A4 to the Hogarth Roundabout. Take the Richmond Exit (A316) from the Hogarth Roundabout. Take the fourth road turning on the left Staveley Gardens / Riverside Drive. Take the first left at the mini roundabout, drive to the end past the speed humps and raised flower beds. Turn right and you will come into the yard where the market is held

From the North and East

The simplest route is to head into Hammersmith. Take the A4 west from Hammersmith Roundabout until you reach the Hogarth Roundabout Then follow the direction from the Hogarth Roundabout as if coming from the West.

From the South, South-East and South-West

Coming in on the A3 take the Roehampton Lane turning (A306) and follow this to the junction with the A205 Upper Richmond Road, turn right here. This Road will take you over Chiswick Bridge. After the Bridge take the second turning on the right Staveley Gardens / Riverside Drive. Take the first left at the mini roundabout, drive to the end past the speed humps and raised flowerbeds. Turn right and you will come into the yard where the market is held

RULES

1. The PRODUCER named in the application must grow or produce everything sold and attend the MARKET. PRODUCERS may not sell items on behalf of, or bought from, any other farm or supplier. Violation of this 'PRODUCER-only' rule will result in suspension or expulsion from the MARKET. The term 'PRODUCER' includes the applicant's family and employees when they are directly involved in the business.
2. All goods must be grown or produced within 100 miles of London, unless by special arrangement with the MANAGER.
3. The following products if offered for sale by the PRODUCER must be grown by the PRODUCER: fruit, vegetables, salad greens, juices, herbs, eggs, meat, poultry, honey and bee products, cut flowers and plants. The following products if offered for sale by the PRODUCER must be manufactured by the PRODUCER at the premises of the PRODUCER: wine, beer, cider, perry, preserves, breads, cakes, pies, pasties, quiches, dairy products. The PRODUCER guarantees that all products offered for sale or their ingredients have not been genetically modified.
4. Notwithstanding Rule 1,2 and 3 above, in order to provide a variety of produce at the MARKET the PRODUCER may sell complimentary non 'PRODUCER-only' items subject to a prior written application, detailing the produce to be sold. If the application is agreed the non 'PRODUCER-only' items must be displayed separately from the 'PRODUCER-only' items and clearly labelled accordingly.
5. Selling before or after market hours is prohibited.
6. The PRODUCER is responsible for complying with all laws and regulations regarding the production, preparation, labelling, display, storage and sale of goods.
7. PROUCERS must take all waste home and leave the MARKET site clean. PRODUCERS MAY NOT UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES use public rubbish bins for waste or unsold produce.
8. PRODUCERS must post prices and trading names clearly and provide information about production practices.
9. The MANAGER may make scheduled visits to places of production to verify compliance of the 'PRODUCER-only' rule. Complaints of suspected violations of the 'PRODUCER-only' rule must be submitted to the MANAGER in writing and signed. Refusal to permit reasonable visits to the property will result in suspension or expulsion from the MARKET.
10. Each PRODUCER must hold adequate liability insurance. Each PRODUCER agrees to defend, hold harmless and indemnify the MARKET and the MANAGER from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, injury, costs, charges, liability or exposure arising from the PRODUCER's participation in the MARKET.
11. The MANAGER's decision on these rules and all other matters concerning the MARKET is final. These rules are subject to alteration by the MANAGER at any time. Where possible, suitable notice of any changes to these rules will be notified to the PRODUCERS by the MANAGER.
